He **has run** in his room. (run)  
**Has** he **run** in his room? (run)

They **have had** lunch. (have)  
**Have** they **had** lunch? (have)

I **have cleaned** the bathroom. (clean)  
**Have** I **cleaned** the bathroom? (clean)

He **has lost** his keys. (lose)  
**Has** he **lost** his keys? (lose)

The children **have done** their homework. (do)  
**Have** the children **done** their homework? (do)

Tim **has been** in England twice. (be)  
**Has** Tim **been** in England twice? (be)

I **have cleaned** my bike. (clean)  
**Have** I **cleaned** my bike? (clean)

She **has gone** to bed. (go)  
**Has** she **gone** to bed? (go)

You **have lost** your passport. (lose)  
**Have** you **lost** your passport? (lose)

He **has cleaned** the shoes. (clean).  
**Has** he **cleaned** my passport? (lose)

We **have finished** with the newspaper. (finish)  
**Have** we **finished** with the newspaper? (finish)

I **have forgotten** her name. (forget)  
**Have** I **forgotten** her name? (forget)

It **has stopped** raining. (stop)  
**Has** it **stopped** raining? (stop)

They **have closed** the door. (close)  
**Have** they **closed** the door? (close)

She **has had** a bath. (have)  
**Has** she **had** a bath? (have)
